

Students report on RANAS - HUNGARY

The Hungarian students conducted a survey involving 70 participants. Among those surveyed, there were 40 boys, making up 57% of the total, and 30 girls, comprising 43% of the respondents.

Ignorance?

Hungarian students think young people's ignorance is a barrier to sustainable behaviour. But according to the survey, 80 % of the students are interested in environmental issues.

What is in the air?

50% of students takes action against air pollution. 84 % uses public transportation to get to school every day.



Recycling is good for the environment

Hungarian students believe that waste management is crucial in protecting the environment. 84% of students collect waste selectively.



An overwhelming majority of Hungarian students (96%) consider the role of plants in climate protection to be of the utmost importance. A third of students have participated in tree planting and 15% of them support organisations that are involved in tree planting and environmental protection.

Trees in the neighbourhood

Half of the students rate the trees in their environment as important or very important.
